Solano HEALS focuses on combating health inequities by engaging local residents, health care providers, community organizations, and faith-based leaders.

This is done by rooting our efforts in the community and creating a collaborative space for a variety of sectors, Solano HEALS hopes to eliminate health inequities among birth outcomes of African American/Black babies.



**Did you know that Black babies are more than twice as likely to die before their first birthday than babies of other races?** This is true for the nation. Solano County is not an exception.

**Many Black babies are born too small or too soon.** Causing higher risk of short-term and long-term health problems as well.
