		 Community members shared their experience with not having enough time with their newborns after delivery due to employment expectations, and 	

	observations during their medical training that didn't sit well with them at the time but now are validated as being part of a larger scale systemic failure Sakari invited attendees to come back next month to be part of the decision making process in future action steps to address adverse outcomes in pregnancy for African American/Black babies, mothers, and families in Solano County.
